





STATEMENT OF FAITH

Because of the various cultures and Christian traditions represented in the Marion community, it is important to define and then adhere to, the core Christian beliefs as an institution. The Statement of Faith defines the essential beliefs that guide us as The Marion Schools.

Together as an institution:

- We believe that there is only one living God who is the creator of the heavens and the earth, who eternally exists in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit that the Bible is Spirit-breathed and is the inspired Word of God, sacred, divinely revealed through select servants of God and is entirely trustworthy, and the has supreme authority in all matters of faith and practice.
- We believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. He is co-equal with the Father. Jesus lived a sinless human life and offered himself as the perfect sacrifice for the sins of all men by dying on a cross to offer free salvation to the lost and sinful man, by grace through faith apart from works, and regeneration by the Holy Spirit. He arose from the dead, ascended to heaven's glory and will return again to earth to reign as King of Kings and Lord of Lords.
- We believe in the deity and personality of God the Holy Spirit by whose work the sinner is converted and by who's indwelling the believer is enabled to live a holy life, to witness and work for the Lord Jesus Christ.
- We believe that Man (male and female, child and adult) is made in the spiritual image of God, to be like him in character. He is the supreme object of God's creation. Man was created to exist forever. He will either exist eternally in union with God through forgiveness and salvation or separated from God by sin.
- We believe that God created the natural family as the fundamental, sovereign unit of society. God created the natural family to be a conjugal union of one man and one woman through marriage for the purposes of sharing love and joy, propagating children, and providing their moral education. Marriage was also given as a representation of the union between Christ and His Church.
